

FIRING FEES FOR CERAMIC PIECES MADE OUTSIDE OF THE STUDIO:

• By the Piece:

The cost for bisque and glaze firing (2 firings) is 8 cents a cubic inch.

To calculate the cost to bisque and glaze fire your piece (2 firings) Simply measure H" x W" x D" and then multiply that number by \$0.08.

(Example: 10in x 6in x 4 in = 240 cubic inches x \$.08 = \$19.20) **Note: There is a 2" minimum for height on all pieces

• Electric Kiln Rental:

The cost for renting a full electric kiln firing is \$90.00 (this includes 2 firings: bisque and glaze)

The price for a one-time firing is \$60.00 (studio glazes not available for one-time firing.)
